

Dear Student:

Thank you for your interest in the TWRA Hunter Education Course, either through interactive CD or online. We are proud to offer this alternative “home study” course to you and hope you find it both enjoyable and educational. This program allows for student log-in and multiple members of a family may take the course over time. To receive Tennessee Hunter Education Certification through this alternative method, a student must complete all twelve sections of instruction (chapter questions and final test/report) **and** attend a required Field Day. **Note: This style of course is not recommended for youth because it lacks the educational interaction between the student and teacher.**

The next Field Day is scheduled for **Saturday** at **9:00 AM** at the John Sevier Hunter Education Center. Attendance to this Field Day requires pre-registration and confirmation. Register at: [John.SevierRange@state.tn.us](mailto:John.SevierRange@state.tn.us) and list "Confirm Field Day Attendance" as the Subject. A CD can be picked up at the below address on Tue/Thur/Sat from 10 -5 or Sunday from 1- 5 or at the TWRA Regional office. The online course is available through the Hunter Education link(s) at: [www.tnwildlife.org](http://www.tnwildlife.org) and still requires attendance at a Field Day.

A **Final Report and Affidavit** is required to participate at the Field Day. Upon completing the entire course and before you exit the CD program, you are asked if you want to print this report. This printout requires a Notary public stamp/signature. If you cannot locate a Notary, please bring the unsigned form to the class and a Notary will be provided. A final written test is given at the Field Day and each student must satisfactorily complete before receiving the Tennessee Hunter Education Certification.

At the Field Day, you will be required to participate in additional classroom training and demonstrate the following:

- ◆ Firearms safety, nomenclature, safe handling techniques and ethics;
- ◆ How to safely load, unload and fire different type of firearms and archery equipment;
- ◆ Orally answer questions from instructors confirming that you have studied, completed and understand the materials on the CD;
- ◆ Safely fire a gun on the range - all guns, ammunition and shooting supplies are provided;
- ◆ Satisfactorily complete a 100 question(Multiple choice/True and False) exam.

Students should arrive no earlier than 8:30 AM and will be finished with this course by 1:00 PM. **\*\*All students must bring:** (1) - Social Security number for placement on the Student Registration Form, and (2) - **Final Report and Affidavit.**

Notice: A lunch break will not be given other than a 15 minute break needed for test setup. You may bring something to “snack on” during that time and drink machines are located on-site.
